Renewals and fees

- All members will pay an annual fee of £160.

- Approximately four weeks before membership expires a Renewal Application form will be emailed to members for renewal. If membership expires, a £30.00 initiation fee will apply to reinstate membership.
- The Coterie membership is non-refundable.

Guests

- The Coterie encourages industry guest speakers.
- Members may only bring guests to meetings that are specifically designed for guest attendees. Members will be notified of such occasions prior to the event.

Membership privileges

- Membership is exclusively for own use and is not transferable.
